III. POLICY

- A. General. The Registrar's Of ce awards transfir credit according to guidelines in regental and institutional policies. It reserves the right to accept or reject credits ear ed at other institutions of higher education. In general, it is University policy to accept credits eared at institutions of Ily accredited by their regional accrediting association, provided that such credits have been eared through university-level courses appropriate to the student's degree program at the University.
 - The University subscribes to (1) statutory mandates regarding transfir credits, (2) statewide policy on transfir and a liculation among Utah public colleges and universities, and (3) articulation agreements between the University and other institutions.
 - Graduates of U tah's accredited community colleges holding the A ssociate of A rts (A A) or A ssociate of Science (A S) degree, and students from other frurOyear colleges and universities in the U tah System of Higher Education whose registrar certifies that they have completed 62-64 semester hours and appropriate general education requirements will be admitted to SUU if they have a 200 or higher GPA, and they will not be required to complete additional general education requirements at SUU.
